

HOW TO DE-SKUNK AN ANIMAL:

To completely remove the odour, **NokOut** must come into direct contact with the problem

IMPORTANT: **CATS:** Use an “Elizabethan Collar” to stop your cat from cleaning itself and ingesting any skunk oil that may be on its skin.

IMPORTANT: Always do a patch test to check for colour fastness. OdorTECH cannot be responsible for any issues of discolouration, fading, etc. May cause fading if exposed to direct sunlight before fully dry.

STEP 1: PRE-TREATMENT DIRECTIONS

If any products or remedies other than **NokOut** have been applied to the animal to try to remove the skunk oil, you must neutralize the other application before applying **NokOut**. Do the following pre-treatment (if you didn't use any, go to Step 2):

1. Mix a solution of 3 heaping tablespoons of baking soda and ½ litre of warm water.
2. Apply this solution to all previously treated areas of the animal making sure to soak the fur down to the skin.
3. Let stand for 15-20 minutes, rinse thoroughly and towel or blow dry. Once this is done, you can apply **NokOut**.

STEP 2: TREATMENT DIRECTIONS

1. **SHAKE BOTTLE WELL BEFORE USING.** Spray the affected area with **NokOut** (at full strength), rubbing and massaging it (soaking it down into the fur), making sure the **NokOut** makes full contact with the skunk oil and skin in the affected area. **NokOut** must come in contact with the odour in order to work properly.
2. If the pet has been sprayed in the face area, pour or spray a small amount of **NokOut** into your hand or a bowl and apply with your hand or a sponge to the face making sure to avoid the eye area. Do not rinse the animal - let the animal dry naturally or blow dry. **NokOut** works as it dries so let it dry thoroughly – wait 24 hours.
3. If the odour persists after the pet is dry, repeat the process. It may take several applications depending how close your pet was to the skunk when sprayed. The nose area may be done with a cotton swab or paper towel soaked in **NokOut**. If the skunk smell has transferred to your skin or clothing, it may be removed by spraying or laundering with **NokOut**. If using on your hands, let them air dry to eliminate the odour completely.

STEP 3: PET SHAMPOO

1. Wash your pet with **NokOut Pet Shampoo** to get rid of the oily residue from the skunk oil.
2. Shake the bottle well before using it. Wet the animal's coat thoroughly and flush the coat and skin of any odour causing substances.
3. The shampoo comes in a concentrated form – start with a “quarter” sized amount. Depending on the size of the animal, you may need more product.
4. Starting at the animal's head and neck, work the shampoo into the coat, working backwards towards the tail.
5. Rinse thoroughly and repeat if necessary. Use as often as needed. Avoid contact with eyes but if any shampoo gets in the eyes, rinse with lots of water.
